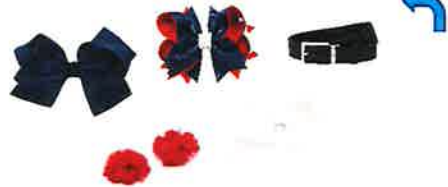


STUDENT DRESS CODE

Student appearance (clothing and grooming) significantly affects the way others respond to them. Since it is our duty to provide an educational atmosphere conducive to learning, minimizing disruptions or distractions, and to protect the health, safety, and morals of students, all students must abide by the uniform code of dress outlined by BSSP when the student is on any school premises or at any school sponsored activity, regardless of location.

BSSP's Uniform Code of Dress is outlined below, and may be changed by the Principal at any time. Failure or refusal to abide by the Dress Code may result in progressive student discipline, up to and including suspension, expulsion, and/or disenrollment.

Mass Uniform: Boys and Girls grades K through 8th



Accessories: Hair accessories can be solid or any pattern of the following colors navy, red and white.

Belts solid black

PE Uniform for boys and girls grades VPK through 8th



Cold Weather: for Boys and Girls grades VPK through 8th



White Socks and shoes:

Anklet Socks/ knee high socks shoes must be solid black



Dress Code NO's

- NO** color hoodies or Sweatshirts
- NO** earrings or long hair for Boys
- NO** nail polish or Acrylic nails
- NO** color hair, No hoops earrings or dangles
- NO** sequins, rhinestones or glitter
- NO** Neon, red, or blue on hair accessories, laces or shoes.
- NO** light up shoes
- NO** tight, faded, torn or stylized pants
